The Trillium Global Sustainable Opportunities Fund is actively managed with a concentrated high-conviction, sustainability-themed strategy that invests in companies driving the transition to a more sustainable economy.

The strategy employs holistic, fully integrated fundamental equity analysis that incorporates ESG factors and emphasises growth companies priced at reasonable valuations. Companies must be able to demonstrate that they are contributing to one of the three core sustainability themes through their core business: climate solutions, economic inclusion and healthy living.
