About the Fund

With an actively managed, diversified portfolio of global equities, the Trillium ESG Global Equity Fund provides the potential for long-term capital growth by investing in companies that are leaders in managing environmental, social and governance (ESG) risks and opportunities, have above average growth potential and are reasonably valued.

With a long history in shareholder advocacy and public policy work, Trillium leverages the power of company ownership to promote positive social and environmental change while seeking to fulfil the Fund's investment return objective.



ESG screening

ESG screening is an integral part of Trillium's company selection process for the Fund. Trillium's process involves exclusionary screens designed to prevent the inclusion of companies based on the company's business activities.

Trillium employs exclusionary screens under which the Fund does not invest in companies that derive a material proportion of their total gross revenue, as reported by the company in audited financial statements or other reports, from specified activities. Trillium also restricts investment in companies based on a controversy screening process. The controversy screening process is based on data provided by MSCI which is designed to provide a consistent assessment of controversies, whether actual or alleged, based on MSCI's categorisation.

Fossil Fuel Exposure

Trillium's philosophy regarding investing in companies with legacy fossil fuel exposure is to invest in companies with a business model designed to succeed in a low-carbon economy, while avoiding investing in companies with the greatest transition risks, namely fossil fuel dependent companies without a transition plan that Trillium finds credible.
